Online Course Questionnaire (OCQ)

The Bloomington Faculty Council (BFC) policy (April 2012) requires that all courses shall be evaluated by an online course questionnaire (OCQ). On April 29, 2014, the BFC approved the nine quantitative and two open-ended items below for this questionnaire. (If academic units have their own open-ended items, items 10 & 11 are optional.)

Item sequence: OCQ items 1 – 9 appear first, followed by department-specific, faculty-specific, and all open-ended items will appear last. Please note that the headers below do not appear on the OCQ. Individual faculty reports and unit reports will include descriptive statistics for OCQ items 1 – 9 and display open-ended comments by question. Results for items 1 – 4 and the two open-ended items will be used in the promotion and tenure process. Results for items 5 – 9 will be accessible to students, with access through IU-authenticated login. Student-access results will appear on a dashboard with visual displays of descriptive statistics.
