Reason	We received a large donation of DVDs that were added to the collection.

Reason	The previous year's ILL numbers were quite high; looking at the year prior (for 2021/2022), our ILL numbers for this year are more in line with ILL docs received (938 for that year). It's possible that last year faculty were working on grants and/or conducting large scale literature reviews which have been completed and so their need for research we do not subscribe to has declined. We also have increased access to e-journals through a pay-per-article service (paid for by the library) that automatically provides access to our researchers without them having to submit ILL requests.
